<u>Christian Education:</u> VBS Volunteer Meeting was held August 6, 2023 with 7 committee members in attendance. The Theme for VBS: Knights of the North Castle – Armour of God. Leading With Care Training was scheduled for Saturday, August 19th at 2:00. Two of the volunteers are CPR and First Aid trained. There were 5 registrations and 3 possible registrations for VBS which was running August 21-25.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: July Operating Income: \$20,254.63; Expenses: \$16,006.54 – SURPLUS of \$4,248.09 Year to date deficit is \$11,336 for general operations.

Income: Receipted: \$13,386; Loose: \$80, Facility Rental: \$4,850; Bank Interest \$10.53, Fundraising \$1,728 **Designated Income**: PWS&D \$260; Presbytery Sharing \$130; Capital Repair \$440; Birthday Church \$91.75.

<u>Mission and Outreach:</u> The Yard Sale on June 24th raised \$650 for PWS&D. Several hundred people from the community attended as well as 30 Paulinites. We were able to recycle material goods and provide low-cost items to our community. In August, we are collecting healthy snacks for Westgate Public School with final collection on August 27th. In September, we are asking everyone to wear an orange T-shirt on September 24th for Truth & Reconciliation Sunday. Karolyn Gagnier is putting Rev. Lisa in touch with an Indigenous Elder to see if they can participate in that service. Next meeting is September 12th.

<u>Congregational Life:</u> Coffee Hosts are needed for coffee after church on Sunday in order for this ministry work to continue. The Women's Retreat is September 15-17 at Camp Kintail at a cost of \$210. There will be a Hot Dog lunch on Rally Day – Sunday, September 10.

<u>Fundraising:</u> Thanks to everyone who donated \$558 for the cost of the BBQ. Approximately 56 people attended our Summer Hamburger dinner on Saturday July 22, 2023. Our costs were minimal due to the fact that everything except the meat was donated by members of the fundraising committee and congregation. After expenses, we raised \$1,045.04 for the General Operating Fund. The next event is the Summer Steak BBQ on Saturday, August 26. On November 18, 2023 there will a Dinner Theatre with the play, "Charlie's Aunt." A Pointsettia Bazaar will be held December 8, 2023. Proceeds are for the General Operating Fund.
